Who is this for

Pet owners, new dog guardians, and rescue-centre volunteers.

What you'll study

Unit 1 — Canine Health Care

10 GLH

Routine health requirements and disease prevention — vaccinations, parasite control, grooming, nutrition — and when to seek veterinary support.

Unit 2 — Canine Training and Behaviour

10 GLH

Normal vs abnormal behaviour, welfare-related signals (aggression, stress), and basic handling to keep dogs calm and safe.

Assessment

Knowledge-based — written responses for each unit. No timed exam. Typical completion in 2–4 months at your own pace.

Common questions

Is the Level 2 Award Ofqual-recognised?

Yes. The Level 2 Award in Canine Care and Welfare is regulated by Ofqual and appears on the Register of Regulated Qualifications. It is awarded by Skills and Education Group (SEG).

How long does it take?

20 guided learning hours. Most learners finish in 2–4 months of part-time study.

Do I need any prior qualifications?

No. Level 2 is suitable for pet owners starting from scratch, with no canine-care background.

When can I enrol?

Sign up on the Visa&Momo courses page to be notified the moment enrolment opens. There's no subscription and no spam.

How much will the certificate cost?

Learning is free. When Ofqual-recognised certificates are available, the Level 2 certificate will cost £30 (covers the Ofqual centre fee, admin and audit-log retention).
